Violence Against Women

From birth to death, in peace and war, women face discrimination and violence at the hands of the state, the community and the family.

The Declaration on the Elimination of Violence Against Women 1993

"any act of gender-based violence that results in, or is likely to result in physical, sexual, or psychological harm or suffering to women, including threats of such acts, coercion or arbitrary deprivation of liberty, whether occurring in public or private life"

The Declaration on the Elimination of Violence Against Women 1993

- Physical, sexual and psychological violence in and outside of the family.
- Dowry related violence.
- Female genital mutilation
- Sexual harassment at work, & schools
- Trafficking and forced prostitution
- State condoned violence

Violence Against Women

U.S. Statistics

- ❑ 73% of family violence victims are female.
- ❑ 30-70 % undergraduate women a year will be sexual harassed.
- ❑ 30% of all women are battered at least once in their adult lives.
- ❑ At least 20% of women have been victim of incest sometime in their lives.

Violence Against Women

U.S. Statistics

- ❑ 2 to 4 million women of all races and classes are battered each year.
- ❑ Every year 1.2 million women are forcibly raped by their current or former male partners.
- ❑ Somewhere in America, a woman is raped every 2 minutes.
- ❑ Somewhere in America a woman is battered, usually by her intimate partner, every 15 seconds.

Violence Against Women

Global Perspective

- 60 million girls who would otherwise be expected to be alive are "missing" from various populations, mostly in Asia, as a result of sex-selective abortions, infanticide or neglect.

Global Perspective

- 1 in 3 women and girls had been beaten or sexually abused in her lifetime. *UN Commission on the Status of Women, 2000*

- 4 million women and girls are trafficked annually. *United Nations*

Violence Against Women

Global Perspective

- ❑ An estimated one million children, mostly girls, enter the sex trade each year *UNICEF*
- ❑ *So-called "honor killings" take the lives of thousands of young women every year, mainly in North Africa, Western Asia and parts of South Asia. In 1999, more than 1000 women in Pakistan were victims of honor crimes.*

Global Perspective

- More than 90 million African women and girls are victims of female circumcision or other forms of genital mutilation
